Option 2: Portfolio

This applicant manual is designed to explain the admission process in according to Chulalongkorn University Announcement Admission to the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program) Faculty of Engineering for the Academic Year 2026.

This manual provides some examples of evidence but not limiting what you can submit. Applicants can view detailed portfolio assessment score criteria in portfolio evaluation criteria.

Please read the instruction below very carefully. Failure to follow the guidelines may lead to an incomplete application.

Application registration and documents submission:

1. To complete the application process, all applicants must submit the required documents via ISE application website: <https://admission.ise.eng.chula.ac.th/Inter/>

***** ISE will only consider applicants who successfully submit the documents. *****

- Fill out all the required spaces in the application form
- Upload and submit the documents files as PDF on the application website
- Registration fee (1,000 baht): It can be paid by QR Code or Credit Card through the system.
- If the status on the website does not change from “submitted” to “document checked” within 5 working days after you submit your application, please contact our staff promptly.

Note that ISE will only accept the documents that are submitted by by February 6, 2026 (Round 1), by May 1, 2026 (Round 2)

2. Required documents
 - 2.1. **Application form** with ID photo on the first page (Fill out the form in the admission system).
 - 2.2. **Copy of High school certificate** (Signed to certify)
 - 2.2.1. **High school equivalency certificate** issued by CU-ATC for students who use grade 12 equivalence (GED, IB, etc.) or
 - 2.2.2. Applicants who are currently enrolled in Grade 12 must submit a certified copy of their student status certificate. **If admitted, they are required to submit an official high school graduation certificate or a high school equivalency certificate issued by CU-ATC by the admission confirmation date, no later than July 31, 2026.**
 - 2.3. **Original high school transcript and copy of transcript** (Signed to certify) showing **GPAX in Thai 4.00 system** of Grade 10-12 (M4-M6) or
 - 2.3.1. If the high school GPAX is not on a 0.00–4.00 scale, or if any course has a score above 4.00 (e.g., A+ equivalent to 4.3), or if the academic transcript includes results beyond the high school level (Grades 10–12), applicants **must submit their transcript to CU-ATC** to request GPAX calculation and obtain a **GPA equivalency certificate, which must be submitted along with other required documents.**
 - 2.4. A certified copy of **English proficiency test scores**

***Students who have enrolled at least two years in high schools that classes are instructed in English may submit the certificate issued by the school in place of the passing English proficiency test score.**
 - 2.5. A certified **copy of passport**
 - 2.6. A copy of **Name change certificate** (in case of names in the application documents do not match)
