Announcement from Chulalongkorn University Admission to the Bachelor of Engineering International Program Faculty of Engineering for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission)

The Chulalongkorn University has authorized the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program), Faculty of Engineering, to select applicants for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission). The admission criteria are as follows:

1. Applicant Requirements

Applicants must have completed <u>or</u> currently be in their final year of high school. Applicants who have graduated from international schools in Thailand accredited by the Ministry of Education must submit their school transcript. Otherwise, applicants need to obtain an equivalence certificate from Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center (CU-ATC).

- **1.1.** Applicants must submit the scores of the following proficiency tests in *item 1.1.1-1.1.3*. At least 2 out of the 3 items must meet the following requirements.
 - 1.1.1. Applicants must achieve the minimum score on **one** of the following English Proficiency tests:

- TOEFL (Internet-based)	not lower than 80	<u>OR</u>

1.1.3. Applicants must achieve the minimum score on <u>one</u> of the following Science Proficiency tests:

Applicants who meet only 2 out of the 3 requirements from *item 1.1* must still achieve the minimum score (listed below) on the item that does not pass the requirement to be eligible to enroll as according to *item 5.1*.

1) Applicants whose score in item 1.1.1 does not pass the above requirements must achieve the minimum score on **one** of the following English Proficiency tests:

3) Applicants whose score in *item 1.1.3* does not pass the above requirements must achieve the minimum score on <u>one</u> of the following Science Proficiency tests:

- CU-ATS	not lower than 760	<u>OR</u>
- SAT Subject Tests (Physics <u>and</u> Chemistry)	not lower than 570	<u>OR</u>
- A Level (Physics-9702 and Chemistry-9701)	not lower than B	<u>OR</u>
- IB (Physics HL <u>and</u> Chemistry HL)	not lower than 6	

The official score reports of the tests in 1.1.1, 1.1.2, and 1.1.3 or 1), 2), and 3) are valid only when the tests were taken within two years before the application deadline.

1.2. Applicants must maintain a history of proper behavior and strictly abide by the existing and upcoming University's regulations, principles, and announcements.

If there is evidence shown later that the application does not meet the requirements or provide fraudulent information, the application will be rejected regardless of whether an offer of admission has already been made. Moreover, the applicant may be prosecuted according to law.

Applicants to the Bachelor of Engineering Program (International Program) Faculty of Engineering, Academic Year 2021 (Admission Round) must not be a validator in the TCAS64 system (Round 1), in the central selection system for person admitted to higher education institutions, academic year 2021.

4. Application Process and Packet

4.1. Application Process

Applicants who meet all requirements listed in *item 1* must apply online through the website as detailed below.

The applicants must verify that they meet all requirements according to this announcement and that all the provided information is truthful and correct. If there is any mistake from the applicants or the application packet does not meet the requirements, the applicants will be disqualified.

4.2. Application Packet

- 4.2.2. **Copy of High school certificate** (Signed to certify and accompanied with original) for those who have completed grade 12 or equivalent.

- Applicants have to show **High school equivalency certificate** issued by CU-ATC <u>only</u>.
- 4.2.2.2 For students studying grade 12 (or equivalence) who are pending for certificate; if accepted for admission.
 - Applicants must show High school certificate or High school equivalency certificate issued by CU-ATC on the date of admission confirmation on March 1, 2021 or by August 13, 2021
- 4.2.3. Original High School Transcript and Copy of Transcript (Signed to certify) showing GPAX in Thai 4.00 system of Grade 10-12 (M4-M6) or
 - 4.2.3.1 In the case of high school is not using 0.00 4.00 in GPAX report, or in the case of a course with a score exceeding 4 (eg, grade A+ equivalent 4.3) and/or reporting results other than high school level (Academic transcript with results other than grade 10 to grade 12), applicants have to submit the transcript to CU-ATC and request a service for GPAX calculation. Then the student must summit the GPAX equivalency certificate along with other required documents.
- 4.2.4. Certified copy of English, Math, and Science Score Reports. If the applicants use SAT or CU-TEP/AAT/ATS
- 4.2.5. Certified copy of Thai national ID card, or passport (for international applicants only)
- 4.2.6. Certified copy of Name change certificate (in case of names in the application documents do not match)

The applicants must ensure that all documents listed in item 4.2 are submitted otherwise the Faculty of Engineering will not consider the application under any circumstances.

Submitting the application form means that the applicants have already checked their eligible requirements. Therefore, no refund will be made after the application has been submitted.

5. Selection Process

5.1. Evaluation Criteria for Candidates who are eligible for Program Selection

The Faculty of Engineering will evaluate the applicants are eligible for program selection based on the criteria and required documents listed in *item 4.2*, the weight assigned to each requirement is as follows:

5.4.1 Accumulated GPA (GPAX)	7.5 %
5.4.2 English Proficiency Test Scores	20 %
5.4.3 Mathematics Proficiency Test Scores	32.5 %
5.4.4 Science Proficiency Test Scores	40 %

5.2. Successful Candidates Announcement

The list of successful candidates who are eligible for study program selection will be announced on **April 23, 2021,** at http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th.

The number of selected applicants will be as of the intended number of admitted students as announced or more, in case the lowest ranking selected applicants eligible for program selection have the same score.

5.3. Program Selection

Successful candidates who are eligible for program selection must select their study program from April 23, 2021, 8:30 a.m. to April 24, 11:59 p.m. via http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th

The applicants who did not select their program on the specified date will be considered as waiving their rights for admission. The program selection criteria are according to the attached document.

5.4. Enrollment Confirmation

Successful candidates who are eligible for program selection must confirm their enrollment on April 26, 2021, from 9:00 a.m. – 16:00 p.m. via online by Microsoft Teams. Selected applicants who fail to confirm their enrollment will be considered as waiving their rights for admission. The faculty will announce the additional successful applicants who are eligible for program selection according to the ranking up to the intended number of admitted applicants on April 27, 2021, 8:30 a.m. The additional successful applicants (if any) must select their study 27, 2021, from 4:00 program on April 8:30 a.m. p.m. http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th/ and confirm the enrollment on April 28, 2021, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. via online by Microsoft Teams. This additional announcement shall

be considered as the end of the selection process. There will be no more additional successful candidate announcement under any circumstances.

5.5. Selected Applicants Announcement

The faculty of Engineering will announce the list of selected applicants on May 10, 2021, at http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th. The selected applicants must also report their online enrollment confirmation (round 2) through the TCAS64 system during May 10-11, 2021, according to the Council of University President of Thailand. Selected applicants who fail to report their enrollment confirmation during the specified period will be considered as waiving their rights for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering International Program for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission). In case the number of selected applicants who successfully report their enrollment confirmation through TCAS64 is less than the intended number of admitted students, the remaining seats will be added to the next admission round for the Academic Year 2021.  - Enrollees who graduated from international schools in Thailand or from overseas, which are not accredited by the Ministry of Education, must possess the Equivalency Certification issued by Chulalongkorn University.
- **6.2.** The final selected applicants who confirmed their enrollment in Bachelor of Engineering International Program for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission) will be eligible for scholarship grants according to the announcement of the Faculty of Engineering.

7. Tuition Fees and Special Tuition Fees

Program Selection Criteria for Admission to the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program) Faculty of Engineering for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission)

Major of study

The Bachelor of Engineering (International Program), Faculty of Engineering, offers 5 majors of study; Nano Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, Information and Communication Engineering, Automotive Design and Manufacturing Engineering, and Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Engineering.

Program selection criteria

To select the major of study, including Nano Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, Information and Communication Engineering, Automotive Design and Manufacturing Engineering, and Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Engineering, applicants who are eligible for program selection can apply to a maximum of 5 majors and rank freely by personal preference from April 23, 2021, 8:30 a.m. to April 24, 11:59 p.m., via http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th. Additional successful candidates (if any) will have to select their major of study from April 27, 2021, 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., via http://www.ise.eng.chula.ac.th. The Faculty of Engineering will consider the program selection for the applicants based on their score rank and their preferred order of majors in accordance with the available slot of each study program. In case any of the programs reach the intended number of admitted students, the faculty will consider the next program in the applicants' preferred order.

- 1. Score rank refers to the ranking of the applicants, who are eligible to enroll, in descending order by evaluating their total scores according to *item 5.1* of this announcement.
- 2. Applicants who failed to select their program of study on the specified period will be considered as waiving their rights for admission to the Bachelor of Engineering (International Program) for the Academic Year 2021 (Admission).
