### AERCAP-CHULA ENGINEERING (ISE AEROSPACE) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

AerCap, the global leader in aircraft leasing and the largest owner of commercial aircraft in the world, will award scholarships to 10 Aerospace Engineering students, commencing from academic year 2021. Four scholarships will be awarded to first-year students for four academic years, and six scholarships to third-year students for two academic years.

The value of scholarship covers: Chulalongkorn University tuition fees, Programme fees and Chula Engineering industrial training fee.

Fourth-year scholarship students may undertake a research project in collaboration with AerCap on a research topic, to be approved by AerCap.

#### Eligibility

**First-Year Scholarships:** Eligible scholarship applicants must be first-year full-time Thai students in the Aerospace Engineering Programme.

**Third-Year Scholarships:** Eligible scholarship applicants must be third-year full-time Thai students in the Aerospace Engineering Programme, who have earned no less than 72 credits, and have GPAX > 3.00.
