Depending on the chosen specialization and on the semester, courses are offered 100% in French or in English. Except Semester 9 in Information Systems with courses in French and English.

## MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS – INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION

<b>DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:</b>	To obtain the ECE Paris Master's Degree (the French Engineer Title), Master's degree students must spend 2 years (4 semesters) at ECE Paris. A final project and two mandatory internship placements are included in the program. All specializations available in English are offered and French as a Foreign Language class is included in the program.
<b>ADMISSION DEADLINES:</b>	May 1 <sup>st</sup>
<b>SEMESTER DATES:</b>	Semester dates are the same as for Exchange programs. The complete program duration is 2 years.

## MISCELLANEOUS

Recommended arrival dates	Depending on housing, but at least a few days before the first day of class.
Visa	The International Office will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outbound mobile participants.
Housing	The International Office will assist and guide exchange students in their search for accommodation in Paris and in their application for the CAF (French housing subsidy). Please note: housing is not guaranteed.
Health and personal liability Insurance	It is compulsory for each International student to have an International Insurance covering repatriation and liability prior to their arrival in France. Both insurances must be valid during all the duration of their stay in France. The International Relations Office will provide assistance in obtaining insurance for incoming and outbound mobile participants.
International activities and buddy systems	Cultural activities are organized throughout the academic year for exchange students by the student association ECE International. For example: a rally in Paris, a visit to the annual event 'Le Salon du Chocolat', a weekend in Bruges (Belgium)... Every newcomer will be put in contact with a Buddy that will help them adjust to campus life and guide them.
