Health and personal liability Insurance	It is compulsory for each International student to have an International Insurance covering repatriation and liability prior to their arrival in France. Both insurances must be valid during all the duration of their stay in France. The International Relations Office will provide assistance in obtaining insurance for incoming and outbound mobile participants.
