FAQ for Admission 1 and Admission 2

<u>Admission</u>

- 1. When are the application periods and deadlines?
 - There are two rounds for admission to the International School of Engineering (ISE).

2. How many students does ISE accept for each round?

3. How do I apply to ISE?

Thai applicants must complete the application process as follows:

- 3.1. Complete the online application form.
- 3.2. Print out the completed application form and prepare the following supporting materials:
 - Three one-inch photographs
 - Academic transcript(s)
 - Official test results for all the required tests.
 - A certificate of student status from current institution (for applicants who are still currently studying in school)
 - A certified copy of identification card
 - A certified copy of house registration

Non-Domestic/Non-Thai applicants must follow the application process according to International Affair, Chulalongkorn University at http://www.inter.chula.ac.th/en/

3.3. Submit all documents and application fee of 1,000 baht (cash only) at the International School of Engineering office, Chulalongkorn University, Room 107 Building 2, Faculty of Engineering, during the application period between 8:30 a.m. -4.00 p.m., with the exception of public holidays.

- 4. After the application is filed, can I still update my test results if I receive better scores?
 - Yes, applicants can update the test scores and file the updated application form as soon as it is done within the application period.
- 5. If I had applied in earlier round(s) of admission, do I have to complete the online application form and submit all of the documents again?
 - Yes. Applicants who had applied previously may be eligible to apply again. To do so, the applicants must access their previous application page, edit the information, and update any test scores as needed. Then, print out the updated application form and submit it with all supporting documents at ISE office again.

<u>Test Scores</u>

- 6. Is there any change in Academic Year 2018 Admission criteria from those for Academic Year 2017?
 - Test score criteria are almost the same as last year. This year however, applicants may also submit Advanced Level <u>or</u> International Baccalaureate (IB) for Mathematics and Science test scores.

For Mathematics,	A-level (Mathematics)	not lower than B <u>or</u>
	IB (Mathematics)	not lower than 6
For Science, A-level (Physics and Chemistry)		not lower than B <u>or</u>
IB	(Physics HL and Chemistry HL)	not lower than 6

- 7. I have Advanced Subsidiary level scores of Mathematics, Physic and Chemistry, can I use them for application?
 - To be eligible, the test scores must be specified as Advanced Level, <u>not</u> Advanced Subsidiary level.
- Can I use CU-ATS Physics and Chemistry scores that were taken on different dates?
 No, you cannot. The CU-ATS Physics and Chemistry scores must be <u>from the same</u> <u>round</u>.

<u>Scholarships</u>

- 9. Does ISE offer scholarships for admission 1 and admission 2?
 - The accepted applicants may later apply for ISE scholarships after their enrollment. For scholarship details, please see:

High-school equivalency

- 11. If I have a GED diploma, what documents do I need to submit?
 - 11.1. You must submit your GED transcripts <u>and</u> diploma with your application.
 - 11.2. For tests taken <u>before May 2017</u>, test results of 5 subjects are required with the total minimum score of 2,250. The minimum score for each subject must not be lower than 410.
 - 11.3. For tests taken <u>from May 2017 onwards</u>, test results of 4 subjects are required with the minimum score for each subject not lower than 145.
- 12. If I have an IGCSE certificate, what documents do I need to submit?
 - Applicants for academic year 2018 must submit their test result of 5 subjects. The minimum grade for each subject is C.

Applicant must request for an equivalent certificate at Chulalongkorn University.

Interview, program selection, and confirmation of enrollment

- 13. What do I need to bring to the interview?
 - You must present your identification card at the registration desk.
- 14. Can I choose only one study program?
 - ISE allows the candidates to select up to 4 study programs. It is highly recommended to <u>choose all 4</u>, for your own benefits.

15. What documents do I need to bring to confirm the enrollment?

You must bring the following documents with you to the Faculty of Engineering on the specified date of confirmation of enrollment:

- 15.1. Your identification card to present at registration desk.
- 15.2. A certified copy of your identification card.
- 15.3. Two hard copies of your study program selection document, printed out from ISE application system.
- 16. If I was selected to the study program that not of first choice, will I be able to request for change of program later after my enrollment?
 - Yes, you may request for change of program <u>on condition that</u> there are enough available seats in your destination program and your GPAX is higher than the minimum GPAX of the students in that program. You can file the request form after the first academic year, and at the end of every semester after that.
- 17. If I am an eligible applicant but I did not confirm my enrollment in the previous round of admission, will I still be able to apply in the next round of admission?
 - Yes, you still have the right to apply for the next round <u>unless</u> you have already confirmed your enrollment in the clearing-house system.
- 18. Will ISE accept more applicants if admitted candidates withdraw from the admission?
 - In case of any withdrawals from the previous round, the remaining slots will be added to the next round of admission.
